### **Romans 10:9-13**

<sup>9</sup> If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. <sup>11</sup> For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame." <sup>12</sup> For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. <sup>13</sup> For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord

### **Luke 4:1-13**

And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness<sup>2</sup> for forty days, being tempted by the devil. And he ate nothing during those days. And when they were ended, he was hungry.<sup>3</sup> The devil said to him, “If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread.”<sup>4</sup> And Jesus answered him, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone.’”<sup>5</sup> And the devil took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time,<sup>6</sup> and said to him, “To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will.<sup>7</sup> If you, then, will worship me, it will all be yours.”<sup>8</sup> And Jesus answered him, “It is written, “You shall worship the Lord your God and him only shall you serve.”

<sup>11</sup> and “On their hands they will bar you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.”<sup>12</sup> And Jesus answered him, “It is said, ‘You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.’”<sup>13</sup> And when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from him until an opportune time.
